

2020 Training Schedule

Each year MRCI is required to assign training to all workers under the 245D programs of **Personal Support, Respite, and now Homemaker.** Below is the calendar of when the training will be assigned.

your worker **does not** complete the training they will be *temporarily suspended* and not able to clock in or out through the app, or be paid for the time worked until complete.
